Fabric Requirements

45242 J - 3/8 yard

45271 B - 1 yard

45243 B - 3/4 yard

45247 S - 1/3 yard

45246 R - 1/2 yard

45245 E - 3/3 yard

45247 B - 31/4 yards (backing and binding)

Cutting Directions

From 45242 J - cut 1 square - 121/2" x 121/2"

From 45271 B - cut 4 squares - 61/2" x 61/2"

cut 4 rectangles - 6½" x 12½" cut 40 squares - 3½" x 3½"

From 45243 B - cut 8 squares - 61/2" x 61/2"

cut 20 rectangles - 31/2" x 61/2"

From 45247 S - cut 8 squares - 31/2" x 31/2"

From 45246 R - cut 4 strips - 31/2" x 241/2"

From 45245 E - cut 2 strips- 4½" x 36½" cut 3 strips - 4½" x WOF

cut 3 strips - 41/2" x WOF

From 45247 B - cut 5 strips - 2½" x WOF (binding) reserve remainder for backing

Piecing the top:

Middle Block - finished size 24" x 24"

- 1. Using tool of your choice, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the blue teapot 6½" squares.
- 2. Place a blue teapot square on a light blue ditsy 6½" x 12½" rectangle as shown below. Stitch on drawn line. Cut away ¼" from sewn line and press.
- 3. Place another blue teapot square on the other side of the light blue ditsy rectangle as shown. Stitch on drawn line. Cut away ¼" from sewn line and press. One flying geese set made. Make 3 additional flying geese sets.
- 4. Sew a 6½" x 6½" light blue ditsy square to either side of two flying geese sets. Press seam toward blue squares.
- 5. Sew a flying geese set to the top and bottom of the 12½" x 12½" center square. Press toward large center square.
- Sew remaining flying geese sets to the sides of center square. This is the beginning of your quilt top.

Flying Geese Assembly







First Border:

- 1. Sew a 3½" x 24½" striped strip to either side of large main block. Press seams towards middle block.
- 2. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow square to either side of two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " striped strips. Press toward squares.
- 3. Sew a set to the top and bottom of the middle block.

Flying Geese Border - make 20, finished size 3" x 6"

1. In the same manner as the main block, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the lit blue ditsy 3½" squares.

- 2. Place a light blue ditsy square on the blue teapots 6½" x 3½" rectangle. Stitch on drawn line. Cut away ¼" from sewn line and press.
- 3. Place another light blue ditsy square on the other side of the blue teapots rectangle. Stitch on drawn line. Cut away ¼" from sewn line and press. Make a total of 20 flying geese sets.
- 4. Sew five flying geese sets together from end to end. Make four of these strips.
- Sew a flying geese strip set to either side of quilt top.
- 6. Sew a 3½" x 3½" yellow square to either side of two flying geese strip sets. Press seams toward squares.
- 7. Sew these two flying geese strip sets to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Final Border

- 1. Sew a 4½" x 36½" teacup print strip to either side of quilt top.
- 2. Sew three remaining 4½" x WOF teacup strips together end to end so that you have one long strip. Cut in half to produce two long strips.
- Sew a strip to the top and bottom of quilt top.

Finishing

- 1. Layer, baste and quilt.
- 2. Sew 2½" blue dot strips together with diagonal seam to form one long strip. Press wrong sides together. Stitch to right side of quilt, matching raw edges of binding to raw edge of quilt. Fold over to back and slipstitch.
