#### **Cutting**

**NOTE:** All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (selvedge to selvedge) unless otherwise noted.

#### 22511 A - Panel

- Cut (4) 8½" squares, centering the design on the small individual panels.
- Cut (2) 2" x 8½" strips, centering the design on the brown butterfly strips.
- Cut 16½" x 22" rectangle, centering the design to include the large individual panel and the butterflies above and below the panel.

#### 22516 E - Light Cream

- Cut (14)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "strips; subcut (38)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", (32)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and (6)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" rectangles.
- Cut (2) 2" strips; subcut (6) 2" x 4" rectangles and (16) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (6) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

### 22516 Q - Blue Tone-on-Tone

- Cut (11)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips; subcut (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2", (10)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", and (8)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Use remaining full and partial strips to piece (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $55\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $61\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border #3 strips.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (4) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (2) 2" x 4" and (2) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

#### 22516 H - Green Tone-on-Tone

- Cut (9) 1½" strips; subcut (4) 1½" x 8½", (6) 1½" x 6½", and (2) 1½" x 2" rectangles. Use remaining full and partial strips to piece (2) 1½" x 50½" and (2) 1½" x 56½" inner border #1 strips.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (2) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (2) 2" x 4" and (2) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

#### 22515 R - Red Music Score Print

- Cut (4) 1½" strips; subcut (2) 1½" x 2", (8) 1½" x 6½" and (6) 1½" x 8½" rectangles.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (3) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (2) 2" x 4" and (2) 4" x 6½" rectangles.





#### 22513 R - Red Floral Print

• Cut (6) 2" strips. Sew together end-to-end and press. Cut (2) 2" x 42½" and (2) 2" x 61½" inner border #2 strips.

#### 22514 A - Brown Text Print

- Cut (1)  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " strip; subcut (2)  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- Cut (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip; subcut (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (3) 2" x 4" and (3) 4" x 6½" rectangles.
- Cut (8) 4" strips. Sew together end to end and press. Cut (2) 4" x 62½" and (2) 4" x 63½" outer border strips.

#### 22515 Q - Blue Music Score Print

- Cut (2) 1½" strips; subcut (2) 1½" x 8½", (7) 1½" x 6½", and (5) 1½" x 2" rectangles.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (2) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (5) 2" x 4" and (5) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

#### 22514 E - Cream Text Print

- Cut (3) 1½" strips; subcut (10) 1½" x 6½" and (10) ½" x 2" rectangles.
- Cut (3) 4" strips; subcut (10) 2" x 4" and (10) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

#### 22513 S - Yellow Floral Print

- Cut (5)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips; subcut (10)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and (10)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (5) 2" squares.

#### 22515 A - Brown Music Score Print

- Cut (2) 1½" strips; subcut (2) 1½" x 8½", (4) 1½" x 6½" and (2) 1½" x 2" rectangles.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (2) 2" squares.
- Cut (1) 4" strip; subcut (2) 2" x 4" and (2) 4" x 6½" rectangles.

#### 22513 R - Red Floral Print

• Cut (7) 2½" strips for binding.

#### **Block Assembly**

1. Arrange and sew together (1) 1½" x 2" blue tone-ontone rectangle, (1) 2" light cream square and (1) 2" x 4" blue tone-on-tone rectangle (Diagram 1).

2. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and (1) 4" x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " blue tone-ontone rectangle to the sides of the unit sewn in step 1 (Diagram 2).



3. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " light cream rectangles to the top and bottom of the unit sewn in step 2 (Diagram 3).



**4.** Sew a 1½" x 8½" light cream rectangle to the remaining sides to complete one block (Diagram 4).




- **5.** Repeat to make a total of two blocks.
- **6.** Repeat steps 1-4, and make the remaining blocks as shown in remaining block diagrams.



#### **Quilt Assembly**

1. Sew a  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " brown text print rectangle to the top and bottom of the  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" panel rectangle (Diagram 5).

2. Arrange and sew together pieced blocks, small panel blocks, and large panel unit to complete quilt center (Diagram 6).

3. Inner Border #1: Sew (1) 1½" x 56½" green tone-ontone strip to each side of the quilt center. Sew (1) 1½" x 50½" green tone-on-tone strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center (Diagram 7).

**4.** Inner Border #2: Referring to diagram on page 1 for placement/direction, sew (1) 2" x 42½" red floral print strip and (1) 2" x 8½" brown butterfly strip (cut from panel) together. Repeat. (Diagram 8).

5. Sew pieced strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew (1) 2" x 61½" red floral print strip to each side of the quilt center (Diagram 9).

6. Inner Border #3: Sew (2) 1½" x 61½" blue tone-ontone strip to each side of the quilt center. Sew (1) 1½" x 55½" blue tone-on-tone strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center (Diagram 10).

7. Outer Border: Sew (1) 4" x 63½" brown text print strip to each side of the quilt center. Sew (1) 4" x 62½" brown text print strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete quilt top.



### **Finishing**

- 1. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing together.
- 2. Baste and quilt as desired.
- **3.** Use 2½" red floral print strips to make binding. Sew to quilt using your preferred method.
