Cutting Directions:

A. 23085 A: Main Floral Print

- Cut (6) 5 1/2" strips; subcut (36) 5 1/2" squares. Use remainder of fabric to cut (4) 3" squares.

B. 23086 O: Pink/Orange Bird Print

- Cut (6) 2 1/2" strips for binding.

C. 23087 A: Brown Multi Circle Print

- Cut (9) 2 1/2" strips; subcut (96) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

D. 23088 E: Cream Stripe

- Cut (11) 2" strips; subcut (31) 2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

E. 23089 EP: Cream/Pink Floral Print

- Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip; subcut (6) 6 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips; subcut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

F. 23089 EQ: Cream/Teal Floral Print

- Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip; subcut (6) 6 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips; subcut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

G. 23090 EP: Light Pink Scroll Print

- Cut (10) 1 1/2" strips. Sew (6) strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips. Use remaining strips to cut (96) 1 1/2" squares.
- Cut (3) 2 1/2" strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams; press. Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48" strips.
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" strips; subcut (2) 1 3/4" x 40 1/2" strips.
- Cut (6) 3" strips; subcut (72) 3" squares.
- Cut (1) 5 1/2" strip; subcut (4) 5 1/2" squares.

H. 23090 P: Dark Pink Scroll Print

- Cut (2) 1 1/2" strips; subcut (48) 1 1/2" squares.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (10) 2" squares.
- Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips; subcut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

I. 23090 Q: Dark Teal Scroll Print

- Cut (2) 1 1/2" strips; subcut (48) 1 1/2" squares.
- Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut (10) 2" squares.
- Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips; subcut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

Construction:

Blocks = 10" finished size

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each (H) 2½" square. With right sides together, place a marked square on one corner of an (E) 6½" square. Sew on the line and trim seam allowance to ¼". Press triangle toward the resulting triangle. Repeat for remaining corners of (E) square.

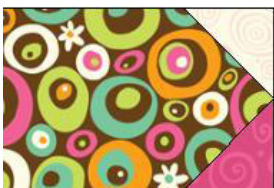
2. Repeat step 1 to make (6) teal blocks using (F) 6½" squares and (I) 2½" squares.



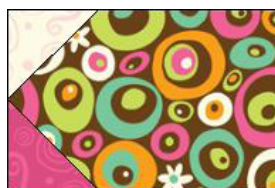

3. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each (H) and (G) 1½" square. With right sides together, place a marked (H) square on a corner of one (C) 2½" x 3½" rectangle. Sew on the line and trim seam allowance to ¼". Press toward the resulting triangle. Place a marked (G) square on the adjacent corner of the rectangle. Sew on the line and trim seam allowance to ¼". Press toward the resulting triangle.

4. Repeat step 3 to make (24) units and (24) units reversed.

5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make corresponding teal units using (C) 2½" x 3½" rectangles and both (G) and (I) 1½" squares.

6. Sew one unit and one reverse unit together with "points" facing. Press seam open. Repeat to make (24) each pink and teal double units.

7. Sew an (E) 2½" square to each end of (12) pink double units from step 6 to form a row. Sew a (F) 2½" square to each end of (12) teal double units. Press seams toward the double units.

8. Sew a pink double unit to each side of a pink unit from step 1. Press seams toward the double units. Repeat with the teal double units and units from step 2.

9. Sew rows together to complete blocks.

Sashing & Rows

1. Create a sashing row by sewing three (D) 2" x 10½" rectangles alternately with two (H) and two (I) 2" squares. Press seams toward rectangles. Repeat to make (5) sashing rows.

2. Referring to quilt image for correct layout, sew a (D) 2½" x 10½" rectangle between three blocks to create a block row. Sew a rectangle to both ends as well. Press seams toward the rectangles.

3. Sew block and sashing rows together to complete center of quilt. Press seams toward sashing rows.



Borders

1. Sew a (G) 2½" x 48" strip to both sides of the quilt center. Sew a (G) 1¾" x 40½" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center. Press all seams toward the strips.

2. The pieced border requires (36) square "arrow" units and (4) corner units. To create the arrow units, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each (G) 3" square. With right sides together, place a marked square on one corner of an (A) 5½" square. Sew on drawn line and trim seam to ¼". Press seam toward resulting triangle. Place another marked square on the adjacent corner of the (A) square and repeat. Make (36) "arrow" units.

3. To create corner units, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each (A) 3" square. With right sides together, place a marked square on one corner of a (G) 5½" square. Sew on drawn line and trim seam to ¼". Press seam toward resulting triangle. Make (4) corner units.

4. Sew (10) units together from step 2 to create a side border. Press seams open. Repeat.



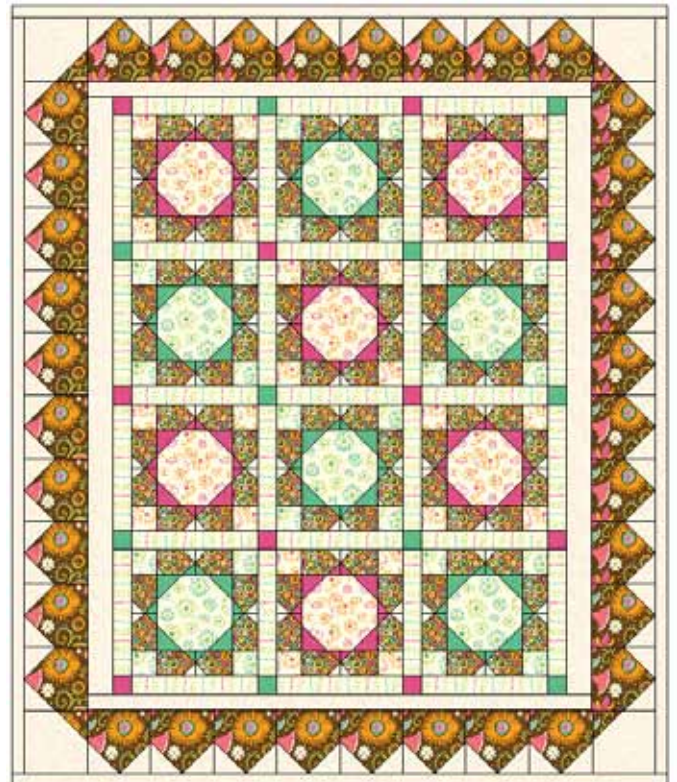

5. Sew (8) units together from step 2. Sew a corner unit to both ends to create a top/bottom row. Repeat.

6. Sew a side borders to quilt center and press toward (G) borders. Sew top & bottom borders to quilt and press toward those borders.
7. Sew a (G) 1½" x 60½" strip to both sides of quilt. Sew a (G) 1½" x 52½" strip to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward (G) floater borders.



Finishing:

1. Prepare backing. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired. Trim layers even with quilt top.
3. Create binding using six (B) 2½" strips. Sew to quilt using your preferred method.
