




HST = Half Square Triangles, QST = Quarter Square Triangles Note: ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise specified

CUTTING Panel 20737 FJ – fussy cut 2 panel images to 101/2" x 201/2" fussy cut 4 panel images to  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " \*20738 H (animals on green background) – Cut 3 rectangles –  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 4 squares –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \*21155 G (pinecones on green) – Cut 2 rectangles -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 4 squares –  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 4 squares -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Reserve remainder for backing. \*21176 A (pinecones on brown) – Cut 2 rectangles – 3½" x 8½", cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 5½", cut 8 squares - 21/2" x 21/2" \*21246 B (blue stripe) – Referring to quilt image for stripe orientation, cut 2 rectangles –  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " with stripe running vertical, cut 1 rectangle 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" with stripe running horizontal, cut 8 squares - 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" \*21176 AE (pinecones on cream)- Cut 2 rectangles  $-3\frac{1}{2}$  x  $\frac{8}{2}$ , cut 1 rectangle  $\frac{3}{2}$  x  $\frac{5}{2}$ , cut 8 squares - 21/2" x 21/2' \*20740 E (cream animal toile)- Cut 3 rectangles  $-3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 1 rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 8 squares - 21/2" x 21/2" \*21312 R (red leaves) - Cut 6 -3½" x 3½" squares, cut 22 - 3" x 3" squares, cut 4 squares - 2½" x 2½" 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth)- Cut 44 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 1 rectangle –  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 2 rectangles -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 44 rectangles –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 40 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 5 –  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (outer border) 21246 A (brown stripe) –Cut 4 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips x length of fabric (inner side borders), cut 7 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips x width of fabric (inner top and bottom borders), cut 8 rectangles  $-2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $3\frac{1}{2}$  21312 SO (gold leaves) - Cut 6  $-3\frac{1}{2}$  x  $3\frac{1}{2}$  squares, cut 22 -3 x 3 squares 20739 B (islands on blue) – Cut 2 – 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares 20740 B (blue animal toile) – Cut 4 –  $10\frac{1}{2}$  x  $10\frac{1}{2}$  squares 21139 FJ (green houndstooth) – Cut 4 rectangles -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut 1 rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### Make Half Square Triangles

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 21312 SO (gold leaves) 3" x 3" squares. Place the 21312 SO (gold leaves) squares right sides together with the 21312 R 3" x 3" squares. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of marked line. Cut along marked line. Press open. 44 red/gold HSTs. HSTs should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Trim to size if necessary.

#### Make Quarter Square Triangles

Referring to HST method above, and using the 6 - 21312 SO (gold leaves)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and the 6 - 21312 R (red leaves)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make 12 HSTs. Mark a diagonal line, perpendicular to the seam on the wrong side of 6 HSTs. Place a marked HST right side together on top of an unmarked HST, with contrasting triangles facing each other. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the marked line. Cut along marked line. Press open. 12 red/gold QSTs (11 will be used). QSTs should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Trim to size if necessary.

#### **Pieced Blocks**

1. Make Nine Patch Units Rows 1 and 3: Sew  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the following order - sew a 20738 H (animals on green background)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to a 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to a 20738 H (animals on green background)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Row 2: Sew a 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth) 21/2" square to either side of a red/gold QST.

Using 2½" squares cut from fabrics marked with asterisks, make 10 additional nine patch units as follows: 1 using 21155 G (pinecones on green), 1 using 21312 R (red leaves), 2 using 21176 AE (pinecones on cream), 2 using 21176 A (pinecones on brown), 2 using 21246 B (blue stripe), 2 using 20740 E (cream animal toile)

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2. Sew a 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth) rectangle on each side of the nine patch units.

3. Sew a red/gold HST to either side of a 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth) 21/2" x 61/2" rectangle, watching placement of the red triangles. Make 22. Sew to top and bottom of blocks, watching placement of red triangle. See Fig. 1. Size of unfinished block is 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"



**Quilt Center** 

Referring to quilt image for placement, assemble in rows the pieced blocks, the 101/2" 20739 B (islands on blue) and 20740 B (blue animal toile) blocks, the 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blocks and 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles cut from the panel. Referring to guilt image for placement, assemble rows.

#### Borders:

First Inner Border: Measure length of quilt through center. Cut 2 – 21/2" 21246 A (brown stripe) strips by length of fabrics to measurement. Sew to either side of the quilt center. Sew  $3 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " 21246 A (brown stripe) strips by width of fabric into one long strip. Measure width of quilt through center. Cut 2 strips to measurement. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center.

Second Pieced Border:

1. Sew 5 assorted - 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>' rectangles together end to end to form a strip. Sew a 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle to each end. Make

- 4. Note: Alternate fabrics per quilt image.
- 2. Sew a pieced strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.

3. Sew a 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" 21155 G (pinecones on green) square to both ends of remaining pieced strips. Sew strips to sides of quilt.

Third Inner Border: Measure length of quilt through center. Cut  $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$  21246 A (brown stripe) strips by length of fabric to measurement. Sew to either side of the quilt center. Sew  $4 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips into one long strip. Measure width of quilt through center. Cut  $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$  21246 A (brown stripe) strips to measurement. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center.

Outer Border: Measure length of guilt through center. Cut  $2 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth) strips to measurement. Sew to either side of the quilt center. Measure width of quilt through center. Cut  $2 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " 21139 AJ (brown houndstooth) strips to measurement. Sew to top and bottom of guilt center.

Layer, quilt as desired and bind.
